At the heart of Europe, I vote!

Electoral roll registration for nationals of a member state of the European Union (EU)

In the European elections, the citizens registered on the electoral roll determine the members of the European Parliament who will guide the destiny of Europe over the next five years. For Luxembourg, this number of representatives is set at 6.

Why is participation in local elections important?

The European Parliament has a legislative and budgetary function and plays an important political control role. As a co-decision-maker with the Council of the European Union, it takes decisions that affect our daily lives. By taking part in the European elections on 9 June 2024, you can make your voice heard in the decisions of the European Union.

Eligibility to vote:

- be at least 18 years old on election day,
- enjoy full civil rights,
- not have been deprived of the right to vote in your country of origin* and
- be registered on the electoral roll.
- * or have lost it solely by no longer being registered as resident in your country of origin.

As a national of an EU Member State, you can register on the electoral roll from now until 55 days before the date of the elections, i.e. until 5 p.m. on 15 April 2024.

It is important to know that as soon as you are registered on the electoral roll, voting is compulsory, but as a national of an EU member state you can have your name removed from the roll at any time.





How do I register on the electoral roll?

• I can register either by going directly to the **Population Office of the Commune of Wiltz** with a valid identity document (identity card/passport) and a valid residence permit during the following opening hours:

Monday to Friday 8.30 am to 11.30 am and 1.30 pm to 4.30 pm Late-night opening every Monday until 7pm.

National registration day on 23.03.2024:

offices open from 8.30 am to 11.30 am for information and registration.
